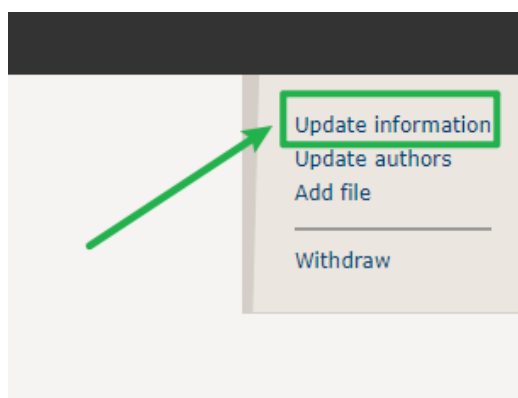

6. Go to "Update information" to complete to review and update your paper information and complete the mandatory fields:



Open Access and Copyright (*). Authors must state on submission which Creative Commons Licence they would prefer – from the list below. The IMarEST preferred option is for the Creative Commons Attribution Licence (CC-BY). However, other options are of course available for authors that cannot meet the conditions of the CC-BY.

- Attribution Licence (CC-BY) – Others can distribute, remix, tweak, and build upon your work, even commercially, as long as they credit you for the original creation and cite the IMarEST as the original publisher.
- Attribution-Non Commercial Licence (CC-BY-NC) – Others can remix, tweak, and build upon your work non-commercially. Their new works must acknowledge you and be non-commercial, but they don't have to license their derivative works on the same terms.
- Attribution-Non Commercial-No Derivatives Licence (CC-BY-NC-ND) – Others can download your works and share them with others as long as they credit you, but they can't change them in any way or use them commercially.

Sir Donald Gosling Award. By kind permission of Sir Donald Gosling, the INEC 2020 Technical Advisory Committee is delighted to announce the continuation of the Sir Donald Gosling Award for authors 35 years of age or under at the time of the conference. First prize is worth £5,000, second prize, £2,500, third prize £1,500. Awards, which will be presented during the conference, will be shared between named joint authors and all will receive a certificate.

Criteria

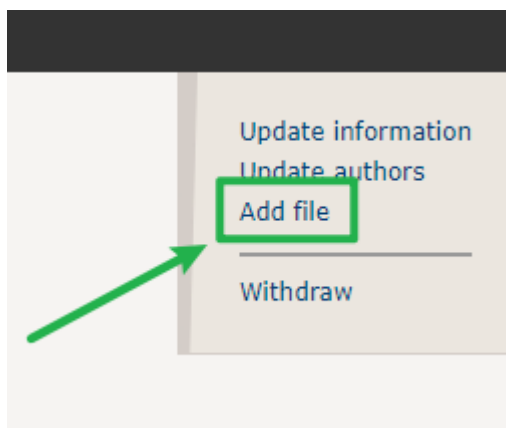

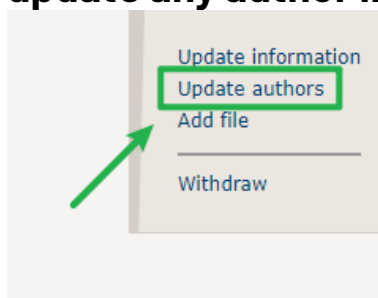
