

Lady Hamlyn Award

Application Deadline: 30 April

The Lady Hamlyn Award is targeted at apprentices working in marine engineering, marine science and marine technology and related topics. The purpose of the Lady Hamlyn Award is to recognise outstanding commitment to professional development within an apprenticeship.

To apply an individual must be:

- Current IMarEST Student (SIMarEST) Member student membership is free and can be obtained here.
- Undertaking an apprenticeship at time of application
- Working in a field related to marine engineering, science or technology

How to Apply:

In order to apply, candidates will need to provide contact details for themselves (complete with IMarEST ID number), as well as a completed <u>referee form</u> to be filled out by a referee at the business at which the candidate is conducting their apprenticeship.

Candidates must also include a personal statement (800 words max) that outlines:

- Relevant academic qualifications
- Why and how they would benefit from receiving the award
- How it would help them through the duration of their apprenticeship
- A description of the project or apprenticeship activity and how/what skills have developed as a result
- A brief passage on an intended/potential 3-5 year career plan the candidate would like to pursue following successful completion of their apprenticeship
- Previous IMarEST Award applications (if applicable)
