



IMarEST Other Book Prizes

A book prize awarded for the students (UG or PG) at a number of universities around the world, or in recognition of an event or competition, beyond the standard book prize. These are typically made due to historical arrangements or are facilitated by IMarEST branches or regional offices. These include:

- IMarEST Greek Branch – Young Members Network
- University of Newcastle in Singapore
- QinetiQ schools power boat challenge

Prize

An appropriate book selected from the IMarEST catalogue and a certificate.

10 awards are made by the IMarEST Greek Branch

3 awards are made by the University of Singapore for the most improved student in Bachelor of Engineering with Honours in Marine Engineering, the most improved student in Bachelor of Engineering with Honours in Offshore Engineering and most improved Student in Bachelor of Engineering with Honours in Naval Architecture

1 award made to the winner of the QinetiQ schools powerboat challenge

Deadline for nominations

These are made in consultation with the submitting branch or institution. All queries should be sent to awards@imarest.org

Criteria

Applications for the award must be made by a representative of the institution, not an individual applicant and should include

- College/University
- Full Name of Nominee with surname/family name highlighted
- Gender of applicant
- Full Title of Course/Apprenticeship
- Full Address to which Prize should be sent
- Details of when the Prize is to be presented



Assessment

The Institute will assume that the application for the award, made on behalf of the individual will be made in good faith and that the institution's assessment procedures are sound.

Rules of the Award

- The IMarEST will consider all properly submitted nominations and any materials supplied in support of them.
- Nominations will be accepted on the condition that:
 - The IMarEST may disclose the names of the nominee(s) and the nominator(s);
- The IMarEST will select the book to be awarded to the winners but will consider specific requests from institutions on a case by case basis.
