





At the time the Transactions were edited by Jas. Adamson, the then Honorary Secretary of the Institute and recorded as Member No. 1 at the founding of the Institute of Marine Engineers in 1880

In addition to papers read that year, the volume also contains the Annual Report, Financial Statement, Additions to the Library and a List of Members totalling just 928 individuals.


