

Privacy statement IMarEST Benelux

1. Information collected by IMarEST Benelux

1.1. Participants to meetings

To be able to organise meetings, we need to register names, e-mail addresses and affiliations of the participants to these meetings (“participants”). Participants are invited to provide this information through an electronic registration form.

The information is used to ensure sufficient catering (snacks and beverages), and to communicate possible changes to the program to participants. If the participant agrees, the information is used to communicate about future meetings, until the participant requests termination of this communication. If the participant disagrees with updates on future meetings, the contact details are deleted after the meeting. If an IMarEST event is hosted by a third party, and this third party requires the contact details of participants (for instance, for security reasons), this will be explicitly communicated to participants before they have filled out the registration form. If the participant still agrees to provide the requested information, the information provided may be communicated to the hosting third party.

If a participant is not a member of IMarEST, and indicates in the registration form that he or she is interested in membership, his or her contact details will be used once for communication about possible membership. The contact details will be stored for no longer than two years or until the termination of the membership.

1.2. Members of IMarEST Benelux

Names and e-mail addresses of members are gathered as a part of membership registration. This information is used for communication about future meetings and events, and will be stored until membership is terminated.

2. Sharing of information with third parties

As mentioned before, IMarEST Benelux may share details provided by participants to the host of the event, if the host requires this. This will be mentioned on the registration form. In principle, IMarEST Benelux does not share information supplied by participants with any other party. Should there be the need to share the information with other parties, IMarEST Benelux will always ask consent of each participant.

3. Storage of information

Information about members and participants are stored in password-protected environments, and are only accessible by board members of IMarEST Benelux.

4. Your rights

At all times, you have the right to:

- Receive a copy of your details kept by us,
- Request a change in your details kept by us,
- Request deletion of your details kept by us,
- Request a transfer of your details to a third party,
- Revoke consent with sharing your details with a third party,
- Revoke consent with use of your details in any other way.

Furthermore, you will receive notice if a data leak occurs.
