Wave energy is arguably the last major form of untapped renewable energy. To date, efforts to develop commercial wave energy technologies have not been conclusive but this does not mean that no progress has been made. In fact, significant progress has been made in knowledge, tools, procedures, software, data management, innovation management, and collection and processing of a multitude of past lessons learned.
