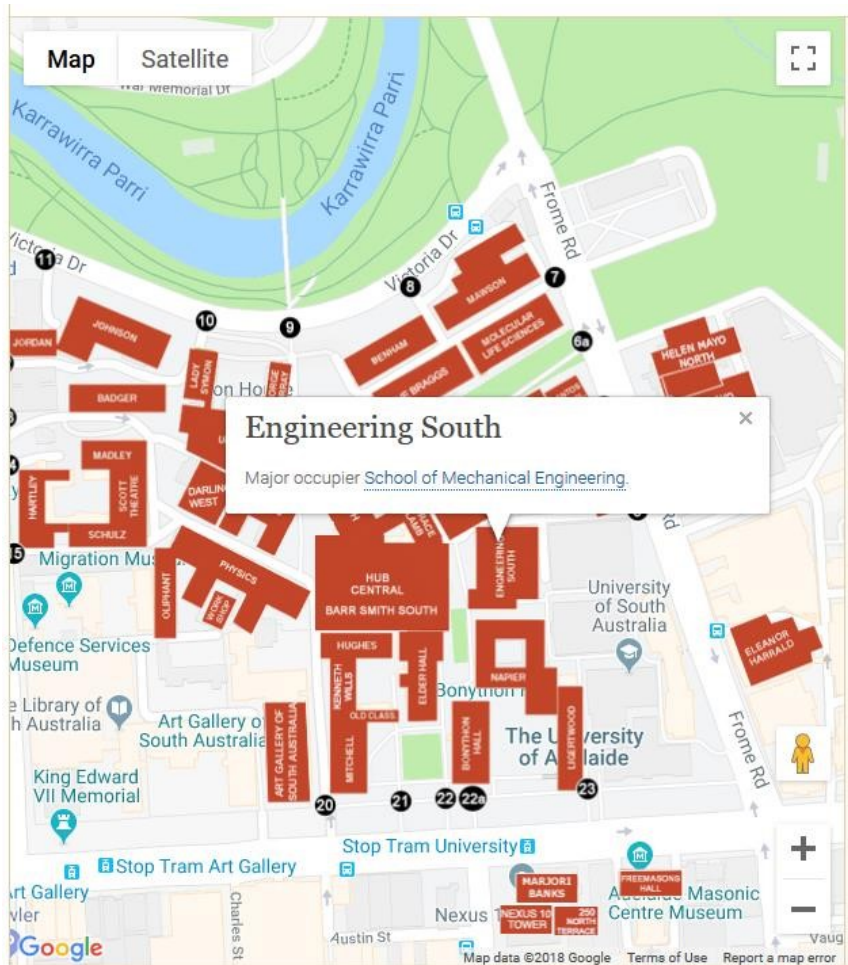




The Royal Institution of

The school of Mechanical Engineering is situated on level 1 of the Engineering South Building (opposite the Hub Central and just behind the Napier Building from North Terrace end). If coming from the river side of campus – go past Inkarni Wardli building and up the stairs to the front of Engineering South Building which will be on your left.

Entrance to the school is via the North Terrace side of the building. Enter via the sliding doors (this entrance is level one) straight through the automatic double doors and into the atrium, with the lecture theatre on the left..

Nearest Male toilets are situated near the School Office and female toilets are up the stairs to the next floor and on the right.
